Bananas are a major cash crop in Uganda and the industry produces a lot of plant waste due to the scale of production. Banana fiber is extracted from the waste from banana harvests. A portion of the proceeds will go to investing in the machines needed to refine the banana fiber and to invest in the Ugandan fashion industry. Featuring clothes from Ugandan designers on a luxury retail website will draw international attention to Ugandan talent.

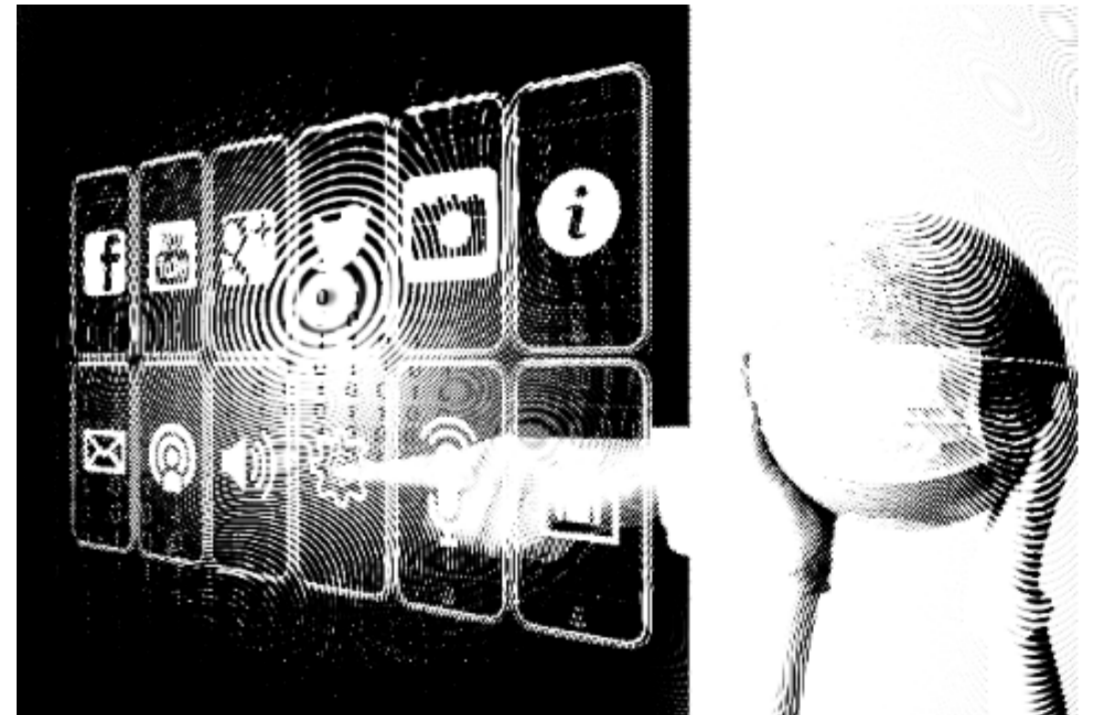

## Telehealth in Myanmar

Will use telehealth application and any social media platform to communicate with patients and doctors.



The new digital immunization card assesses up-to-date vaccination statuses of people in Bangladesh, especially of those who do not have hospital records. A simple scan of the person's arm will collect molecular data that will examine presence of any existing infectious diseases. This would create more accessibility to receiving vaccines, specifically the COVID-19 vaccine, by placing an alert on the person's digital card. Exemptions will also be noted on the cards.

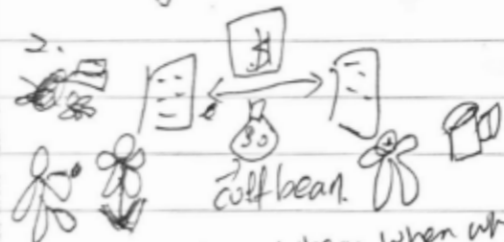

Ethiopia, the first city to power its entire country through sustainable investments, and sourced by its local residents & diaspora. This is the first country to not be reliant on foreign aid.

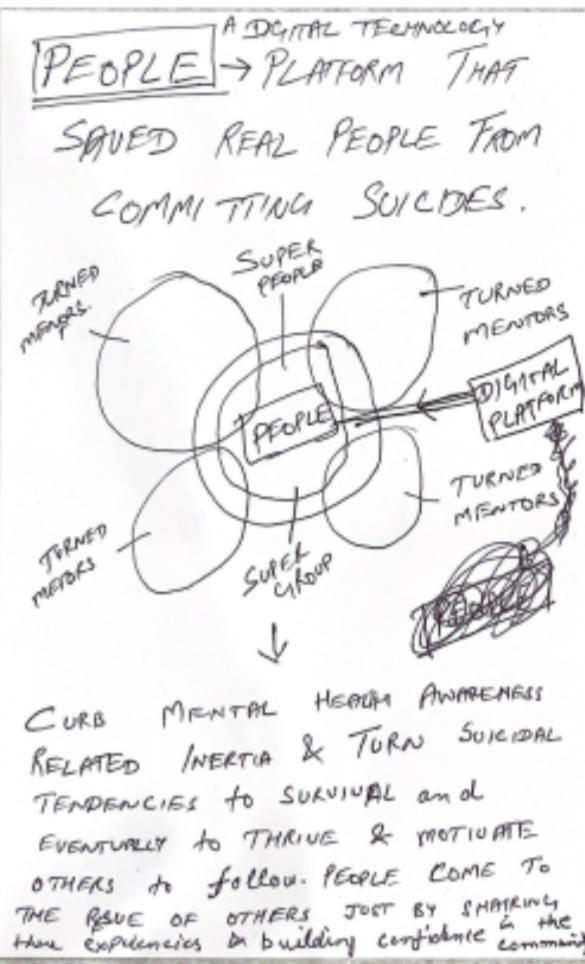

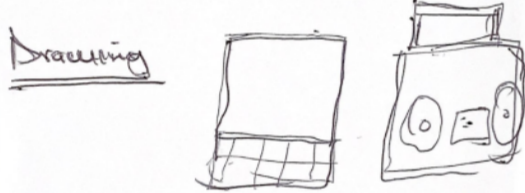

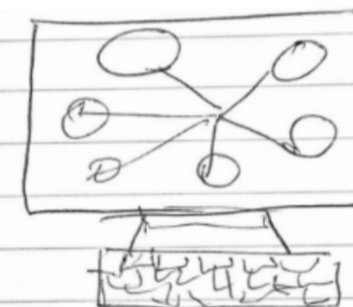

Digital Anti-Corruption Tools are Changing the Status Quo of Governance in Afghanistan.



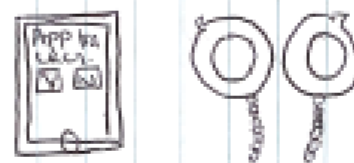

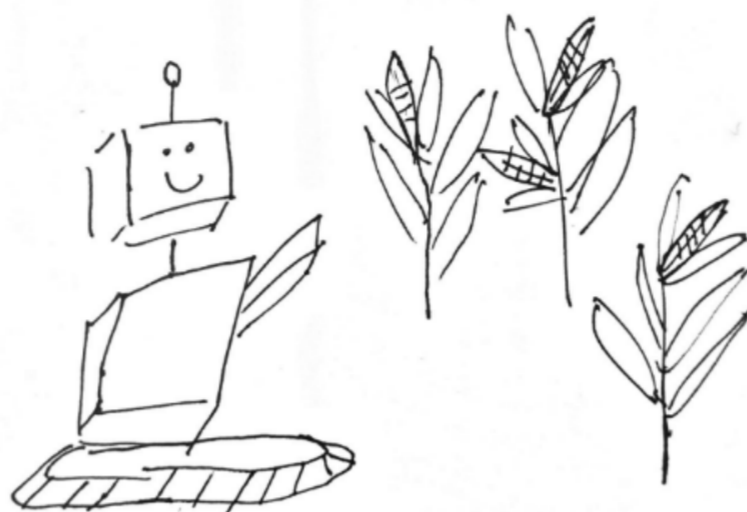

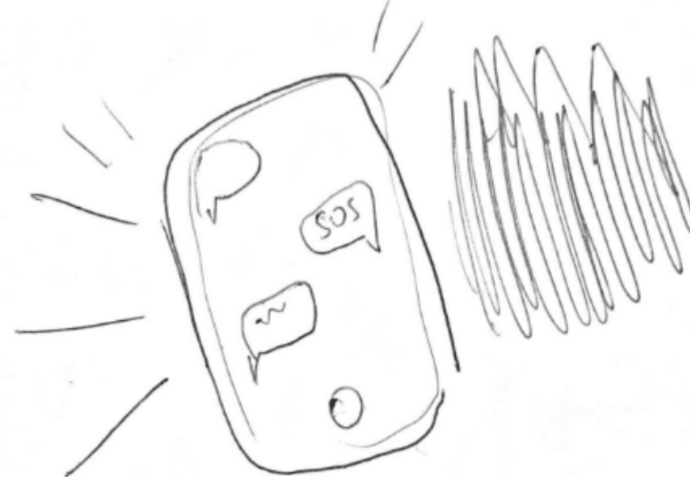

A contextual approach to the design of interventions (economic, social, environmental), considering even systemic issues such as inequality and injustice.

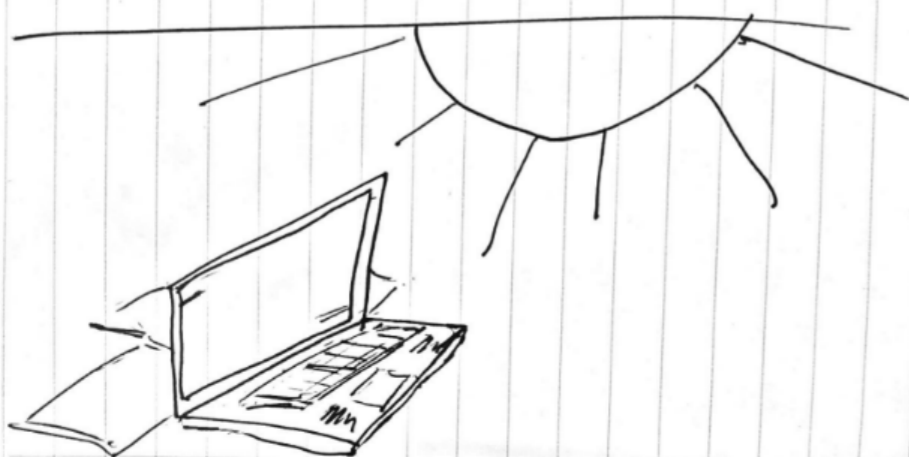
DIGITAL SMART WATCHES MINIMIZE THE RATE OF MALNUTRITION IN AFRICA BY 2050

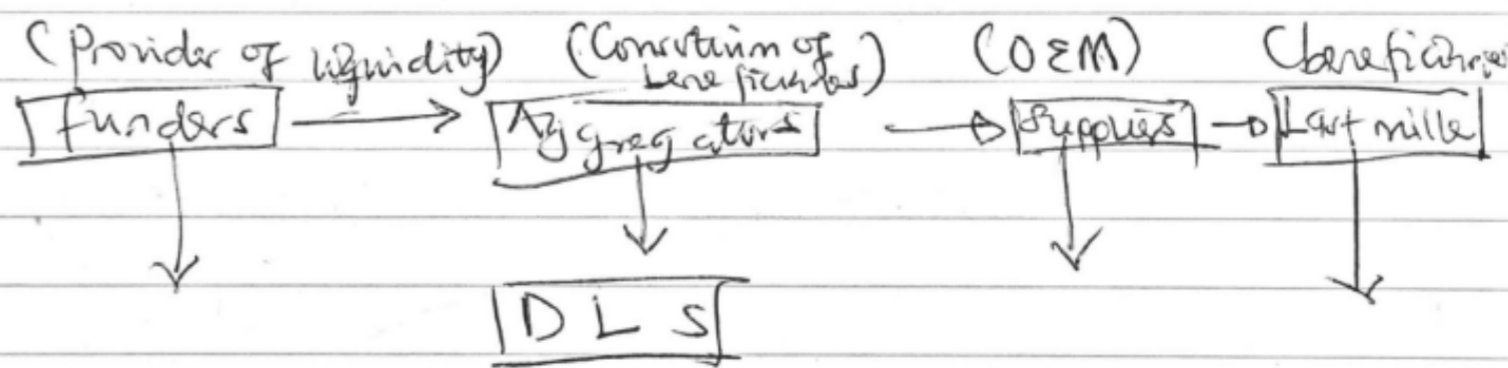
